1. Payment (two options):
 - Option 1: P3R will directly pay any applicable invoices related to this project
 - Please forward invoices ASAP to: hunter.confair@p3r.org
 - If the total amount exceeds the approval amount, P3R will send payment for the approved grant amount to be deducted from the total owed for the project.
 - Option 2: P3R will pay the requester the approved amount
 - Please provide any applicable quote(s) and/or financial documents for the project which total the amount requested (or more).
 - After receiving quotes, a check for the approved amount will be sent/presented.
 - Who to make the check payable to and the phycial address of where to mail the check
 - After project completion, you must submit receipts totaling approximately the amount requested (or more) to verify the funding.
2. Check Presentation (Optional):
 - We would like to offer an official check presentation within the next few months
 - If interested, please share a few dates and times that would work well for a P3R staff member to present the "Presentation Check" and take a photo with some of the beneficiaries of this award.
3. Project Recap: Please send the following items within one month of the completion of the project:
 - Recap of how you used the funding and how many students and families benefited from it
 - Minimally a photo of the Kids of STEEL students who benefited from the funding
