## By the Numbers

- In the past ten years CVSD modified from 1 of out 8 to 1 out of 4 students identifying as minority
- 2 out of every 15 students are receiving Special Education services
- 1 out of 10 students receive English Language services
- 4 out of 10 students qualify for free and reduced lunch, meaning their household income is less than \$44,000 per year



### What does this information tell us?

- Our teachers and staff need to be aware of learning barriers and how to overcome them
- Meeting basic needs such as, socio-emotional, parental involvement, mental health and medical needs (medication management), partnerships with social services (CYF, JPO, etc.)
- Lower socio- economic may indicate more need academically and behaviorally
  - These families may not have access or affordability to preschool, medical care, and other needs
