Additional goals or explanation (if desired):

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Supervision is essential for advanced practicum students to develop profession-wide competencies and to keep the field supervisor informed regarding the student’s activities under the supervisor’s practice credentials. The field site supervisor agrees to:

2. Complete two Program-provided evaluations of the advanced practicum student.
3. Communicate with the university practicum supervisor as needed.

The practicum student agrees to:

1. Participate in regularly scheduled supervision with the field site supervisor.
2. Participate in regularly scheduled supervision with the university supervisor.

3. Alert both field and university supervisors if unable to attend practicum.

4. Engage in on-site practicum activities for 15 hours per week.

The start date of the advanced practicum experience is 08/22/24 and the end date is 05/02/24. The advanced practicum experience will not start earlier, nor end later than the dates above unless the field site, the Program, and the advanced practicum student all agree to the modification.
