John F Kennedy Presidential Library & Museum

The John F. Kennedy Presidential Library and Museum is dedicated to the memory of our nation's thirty-fifth president and to all those who through the art of politics seek a new and better world.



Quincy Market & Faneuil Hall

Located in the heart of downtown Boston, Faneuil Hall Marketplace is adjacent to historic Faneuil Hall and is bordered by the financial district, the waterfront, the North End, Government Center and Haymarket. It is a well-traveled part of Boston's "Freedom Trail."



Boston Tea Party Ships & Museum

At the Boston Tea Party Ships & Museum, you can be a part of the famous event that forever changed the course of American history through a multi-sensory experience that includes live actors, interactive exhibits, and full-scale replica 18th-century sailing vessels!



Freedom Trail Tour

The Freedom Trail Foundation's most popular, introductory, tours highlight the diverse history that took place at 11 of the 16 official Freedom Trail historic sites, featuring Boston Common, Massachusetts State House, Park Street Church, Granary Burying Ground, King's Chapel & King's Chapel Burying Ground, Boston Latin School site/Benjamin Franklin statue, Old Corner Bookstore, Old South Meeting House, Old State House, Boston Massacre site, and Faneuil Hall. Experience stories of the American Revolution, as well as the history of traditionally underrepresented peoples spanning from the 16th – 21st centuries.



Salem Witch Museum

The Salem Witch Museum, founded in 1972, offers two historical presentations. The first tells the tragic story of the 1692 witch trials, and takes place in a large auditorium with life-sized stage sets which are illuminated and dramatically-narrated to immerse visitors in the world of 17th century Salem. The second exhibit, *Witches: Evolving Perceptions*, examines the European witchcraft trials, the evolving image of the witch, and the larger issues of persecution and scapegoating in American history.

Springhill Suites Boston Peabody

Based on 33 paying students and chaperones with 2 staff packages included:

- . \$ 970 per student based on Quint occupancy
- \$ 1,008 per student based on Quad occupancy
- \$ 1,215 per adult based on Double occupancy
- \$ 1,598 per adult based on Single occupancy

Based on 28 paying students and chaperones with 2 staff packages included:

- \$ 1,058 per student based on Quint occupancy
- \$ 1,096 per student based on Quad occupancy
- \$ 1,303 per adult based on Double occupancy
- \$ 1,686 per adult based on Single occupancy

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- 1. The prices quoted in this proposal are based on 30 or 35 participants using one (1) 55-passenger bus.
- The pricing above includes two (2) adult staff packages in double occupancy, based on 28 or 33 paying students and adults.
- 3. The quoted per person trip costs are estimated and subject to availability, fuel surcharges, and final number of participants. Trip costs are not finalized until all contracts are signed and reservations are confirmed. All items are based on availability at the time the Proposal is accepted and the first deposit is received.
