- 2. Detailed description of activities, events and frequency of meetings.
- Students will work to complete the requirements of the Global Scholars program in order to obtain academic recognition at graduation.
 - Students who participate in the Global Scholars program work to show global competency in the following ways:
 - 1. Complete 4 consecutive HS years of the same world language and take at least 4 additional credits in courses that have a global focus (World Lit, Macroeconomics, Shaping of the Modern World, etc.)
 - 2. Actively participate in at least 4 extra-curricular activities that have a global focus such as World Language clubs, field trips, community activities, etc.
 - 3. Complete a minimum of 20 community service hours that have a global focus
 - 4. Complete at least 8 literature/media reviews on books and films tied to global topics
- Students who wish to and are able to, may be part of a Global Scholars
 homeroom where they can collaborate with their peers as they work towards the
 goals of the program.
- Meetings will be held after school once per month (September May). Each meeting will feature a guest speaker, discussion topic, or workshop time.
- Global Scholars will participate in the Homecoming Carnival and Celebrate CV.

2023-24 is not the first year of the Global Scholars program. This program began in 2016. To date, 31 students have achieved the Global Scholar designation. A significant number of additional students progressed through the program, completing some, but not all, of the requirements.

There are over 30 students currently enrolled to continue the program during 2023-24, with more rising freshmen to be added this month (May 2023) or at the beginning of the next academic year.
