



MAIL-BALLOT ELECTION OF ALLEGHENY INTERMEDIATE UNIT BOARD MEMBERS APRIL 2025

An election of members to the Allegheny Intermediate Unit (AIU) Board of Directors will be held in April 2025, by mail ballot. The 2025-2026 election will include filling the following positions on the 13-member Allegheny Intermediate Unit Board:

Five (5) – three-year positions – July 2025 to June 2028

All 378 school directors from the 42 school districts are eligible to cast a ballot to elect candidates to the AIU Board. In accordance with the Public-School Code, individual school director votes are proportionate, as determined by the Pennsylvania Department of Education's weighted average daily membership for each school district for the previous school year.

I encourage you to consider becoming a candidate to serve on the Allegheny Intermediate Unit Board. AIU Board members are responsible to all 42 school districts in suburban Allegheny County, as well as nonpublic schools and charter schools. Candidates should have the willingness to represent the interests of all learners in the County. Being a member of the AIU Board is very rewarding. It provides an opportunity to learn from members of other school boards, to work on behalf of all students and adult learners in the County, and to be better informed about educational trends and issues.

School Code section 910-A requires that each candidate for the intermediate unit board be nominated by a majority vote of his or her district board and that a record of such vote become part of the minutes of the district. **The record of that vote and the candidate's name must be received by certified mail no later than Friday, March 14, 2025 using the form attached.** Note that a district school board may have no more than one member serving on the AIU Board at a given time. On Thursday evening, March 27, 2025, each candidate will have an opportunity to introduce themselves to district school directors both in-person and via Zoom.
