


# **WHAT IS COMPREHENSIVE PLANNING?**

## **PURPOSE OF COMPREHENSIVE PLAN**


• Every 3 years, a school entity must submit to the Secretary for approval a professional education plan. The professional education plan must be made available for public inspection and comment for 28 days, and then it can be approved by the board and then submitted to PDE.



• Every 6 years, a school entity must submit to the Department for approval an induction plan and gifted plan. The induction plan must be made available for public inspection and comment for 28 days, and then it can be approved by the school entity's governing board and then submitted to PDE.



• Every 6 years, a school entity must develop and implement a comprehensive and integrated K-12 program of student services. This student services plan must be made available for public inspection and comment for 28 days, and then it can be approved by the school entity's board.



• Every 3 years, each school district must develop and submit to the department a special education plan. The special education plan must be made available for public inspection and comment for 28 days, and then it can be approved by the school entity's governing board and then submitted to PDE.

Provide robust curricular and extracurricular offerings while maintaining sound fiscal responsibility.








# SURVEY FEEDBACK STUDENTS




What influences your perspective about what makes a good quality education for your students? Check all that apply.




My students' parents share my beliefs about what makes for a good quality education. 96 responses










Overall rate how satisfied you are with the Chartiers Valley School District (CVSD). 206 responses






How well do you feel your child's school is preparing them for the next school year? 206 responses






## How confident are you that your child can apply what they have learned in school to the real world? 206 responses




The school district provides adequate technology to help improve your child's education. 206 responses

## **IDENTIFIED STRENGTHS**

Foster a vision and culture of high expectations for success for all students, educators, and families.

Ensure effective, standards-aligned curriculum and assessment.

67% of EL students demonstrated growth on the ACCESS for the 2022 school-year. 100% of Special Education students at the Intermediate School completed their college and career readiness portfolio.

## **IDENTIFIED CHALLENGES**

Growth scores at the Intermediate School are below the state and standard in ELA, Math, and Science

Partner with local businesses, community organizations, and other agencies to meet the needs of the district.

15% of our High School students obtained an industry based learning designation which is below the statewide average of 26%.

50% of special education students are enrolled in rigorous courses, which is below the statewide average of 57%

**Priority Statement:** 1.CVIS will adopt and implement periodic benchmark (informal and formal) assessments that are aligned with curricula and state standards. These periodic assessments will assist in gauging student growth in specific areas. CVIS will, at least annually, analyze student data with a specific focus on areas of growth.



**Priority Statement:** 2. CVSD acknowledges that students should be prepared for college and career workforce and by incorporating industry designations into our high school course curricula, it is the intent to not only increase the average but to prepare our students further to be productive members of society.



## **CVSD RECENT RECOGNITIONS**

CVMS was awarded the National Schools to Watch. The community, teachers, and administration did a tremendous job preparing for this accolade.

Computer Science for all. CVSD is the only district in Pa which was designated as a "Computer Science for All".

**Allegheny Health Network** teamed up with us to bring the "Chill Bus". Through our partnership with AHN we have been able to provide mental health supports for our students and community in a time of very high need. The Chill bus is an extension of this service with a focus on student athletes.
