Re: 2023-2024 High School Program of Studies

The 2023-2024 High School Program of Studies includes name changes, additional course offerings, and updates to already established courses. The following changes have been made to the Program of Studies:

Applied Engineering and Technology

- Many of the courses have changed from a full-year course to semester courses.
- Makers Lab changed to Fab Lab.
- A semester Aviation Technology (UAV) course has been added.
- Manufacturing Technology has been broken into semester courses: Woodshop and Metal Shop.
- Removed Project Lead the Way from AET Program.
- Removed Introduction to Architecture and replaced with Architecture 1 and 2 - also semester courses.

Math

- Intro to AI & Machine Learning moved from full-year course to a semester course.

Business

- Name Change- Marketing Dynamics to Retail Business Operations 1 *
- Name Change- Accounting 1B changed to Accounting 2
- Added: Retail Business Operations 2 *
- Added: Brewing Success 1 added (this is the course for the coffee shop). (Brewing Success 2 will be offered in 2024-2025 to create a pathway for those interested).

Music

Orchestra had a slight update to their course description

Removed Jazz Band and Jazz Ensemble (they do not currently exist)

Graduation Requirements (page 5)

The class of 2023 is the first class who is required to have a Graduation Pathway identified in accordance with Act 158. The program of studies identifies and explains the five different pathways students can qualify to graduate under.
