# Initial PSSA Data- Middle School

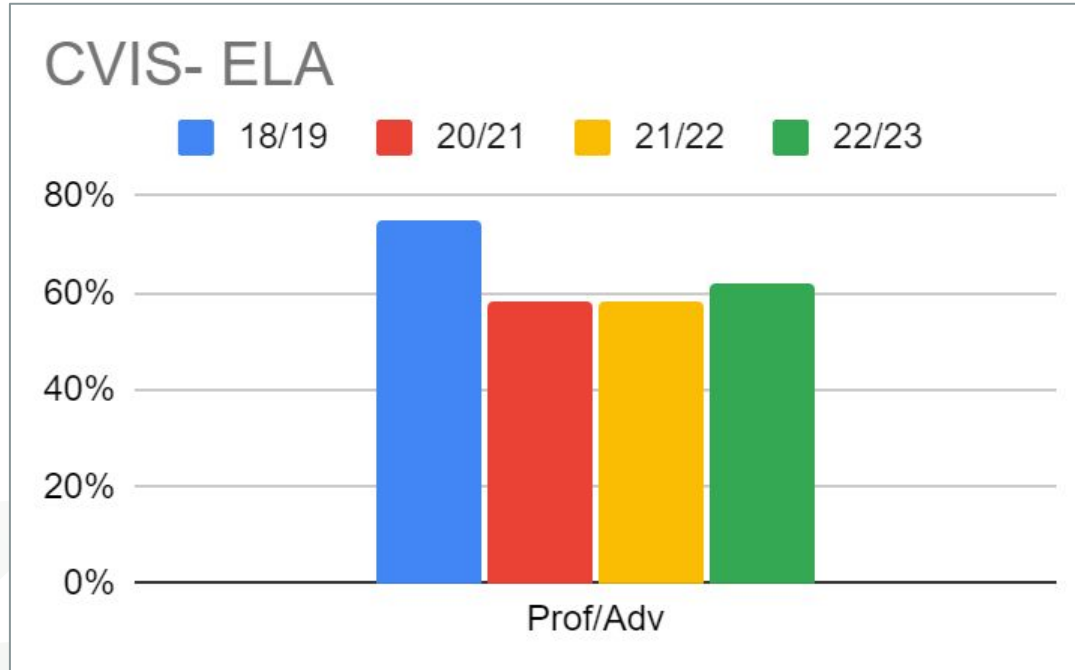




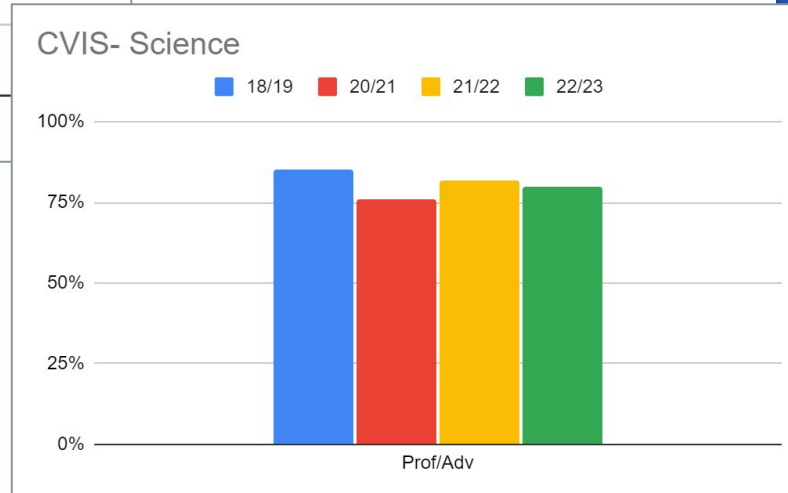
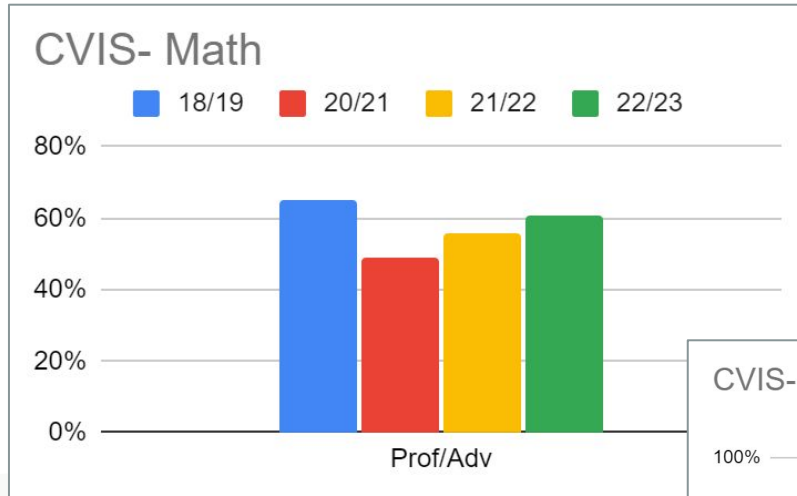
